

## Cased pair of flintlock pistols by David Scott of Edinburgh (CAT#Q)

These pistols are in superb fine condition. I have several brass/bronze-framed pistols but none of them have the beautiful patina as these do; I don't think they've ever been polished.

The engraving is as crisp as the day they were made.

The barrels retain much of what I think is the original blue finish.

A clue as to the quality of these pistols can be found in the barrel wrench; the wrench is lined with brass so as not to scratch the harder steel barrel.
